Who are we?

For 24 years Casas de Cuidado Diario (Daily Care Homes) has been an alternative model of care, attention and protection of small children of working mothers who do not have an adequate place to leave their children during work hours.

Beneficiaries

- **More than 18,000 children have completed the program.**
- **The approximate cost per child is \$5402.00 Mexican Pesos per year**
- **The program serves 91 neighborhoods in 6 municipalities.**





To achieve this, there is a strong team effort that includes:

- **Operative personnel (19)**
- **Program Volunteers (64)**
- **Care Mothers* (120)**

Total of 203 persons involved

*CareMother: is a mother who wishes to contribute to her family in come and the development of the community by caring children of other working women in her own home, providing them not only care for their basic needs but addressing their affective formation of values and needs.

What distinguishes us?

- **Care for boys and girls—offering attention, protection and care to minors.**
- **Integral formation—promoting in them the development of their emotional, social and intellectual abilities.**
- **Nutrition—looking to improve and monitor the nutrition of our beneficiaries by offering balanced menus and constant supervision of their size and weight.**
- **Constant training—to professionalize services offered by operative personnel, program volunteers, Care Mothers and Board members to improve the attention given to our children.**
- **Complementary Programs—such as Computer Science, Music and English.**
- **Self-employment—offering the Care Mother the opportunity of self-employment within her own home without attending her children.**
- **Strengthening of social ambiance—through values such as interaction and participation that offer major economical, nutritional and physical security.**
- **Transportation—school-aged children are transported to their educational centers by the Care Mother.**



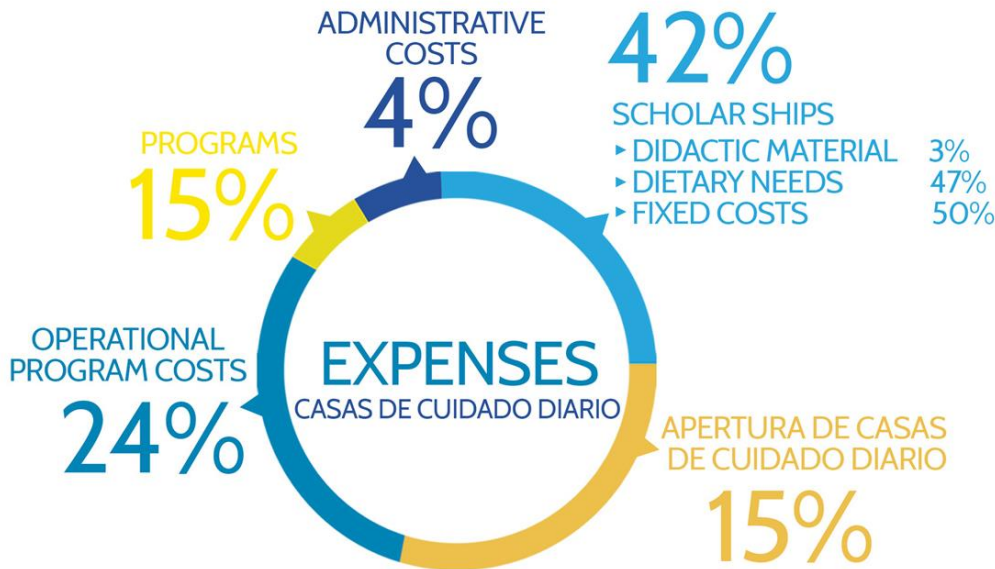
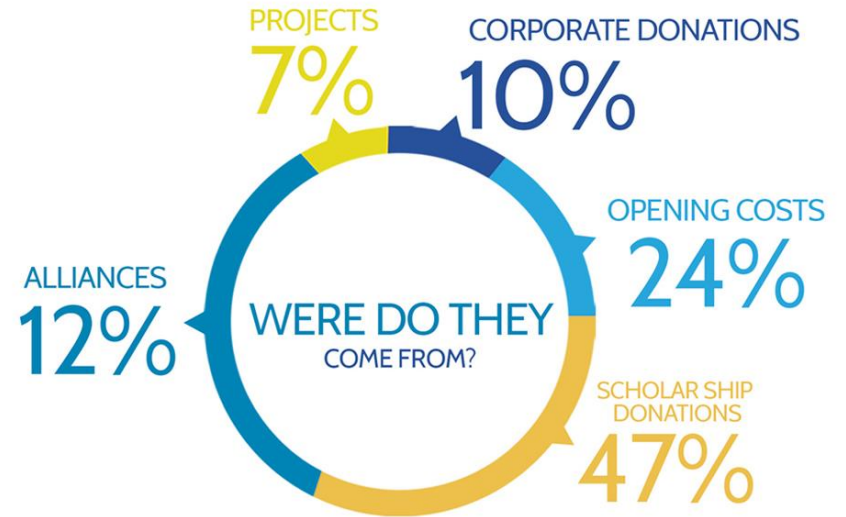


Were cognize the importance of love in prevention

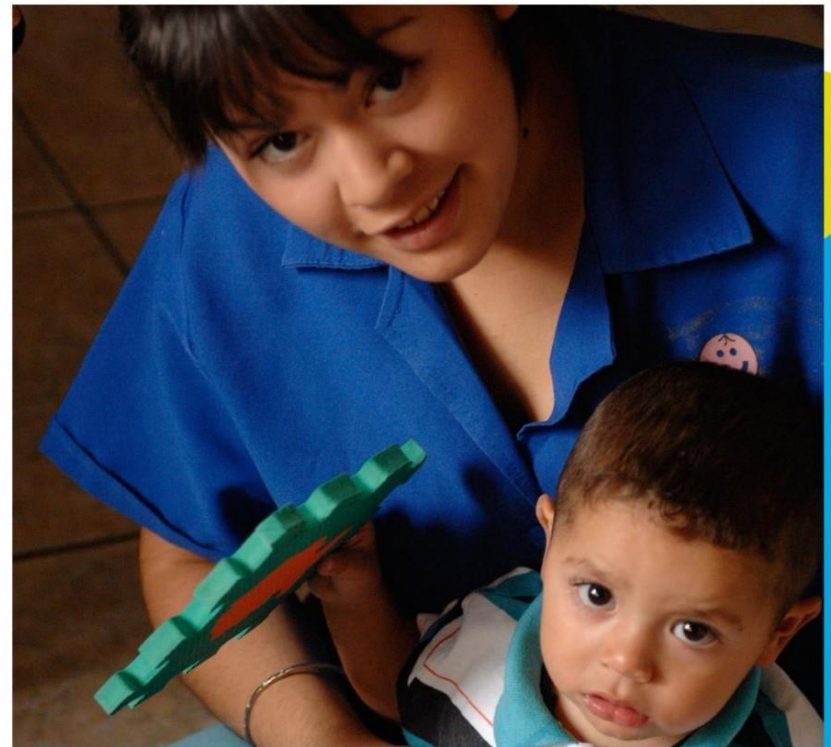
