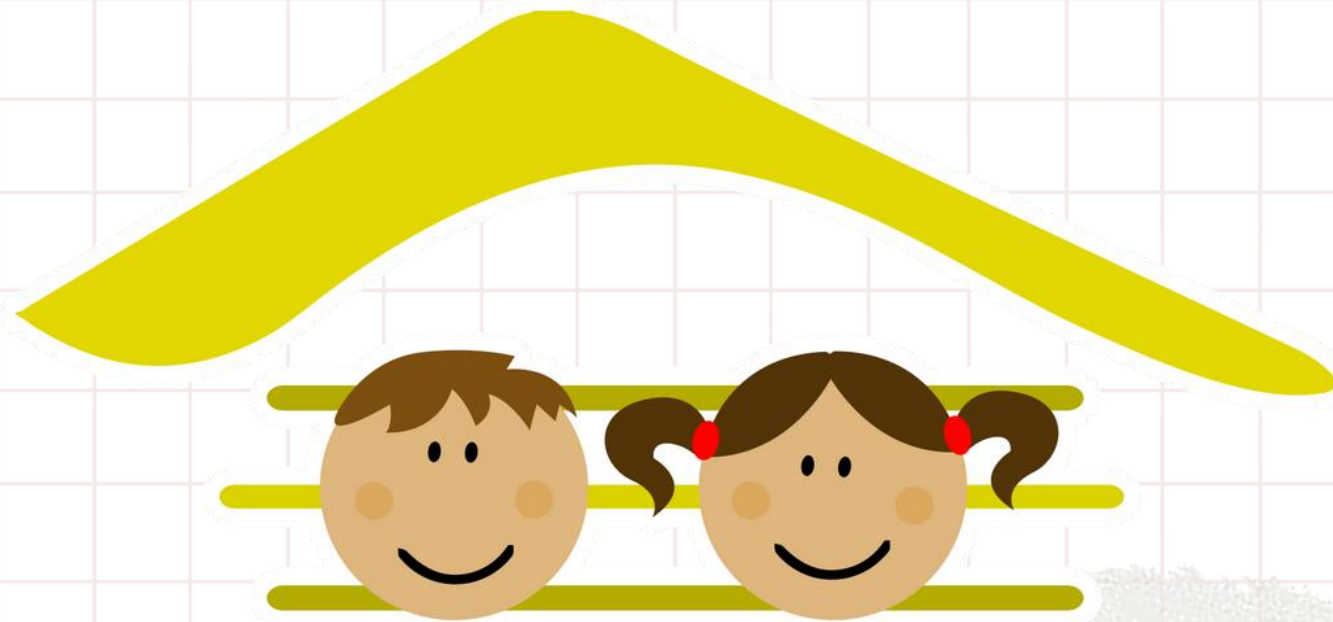

Beneficiaries



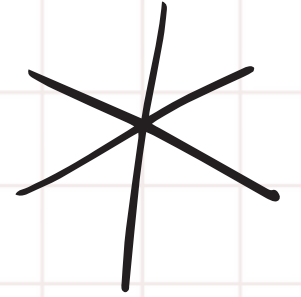
More than **45,000** children have graduated from the program.

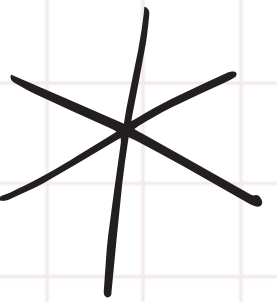
What sets us apart?



- Comprehensive education: Promoting the development of children's emotional, social, and intellectual skills.
- Nutrition: We aim to improve and monitor the nutrition of our beneficiaries through appropriate menus and constant height and weight monitoring.
- Ongoing training: Professionalizing the work of Caregivers, Volunteers, Operational Staff and the Board of Directors to improve care for our children.
- Complementary programs: Such as literacy and mathematics workshops and fine motor skills.
- Self-employment: Giving the Caregiver Mother the opportunity to work in her own home without neglecting her children.
- We strengthen the social fabric: Through values of coexistence and participation, which provide greater economic, food and physical security.
- Transfer: School-age children are transferred by the Caregiver Mother to their educational center.



We recognize the importance of love in prevention...



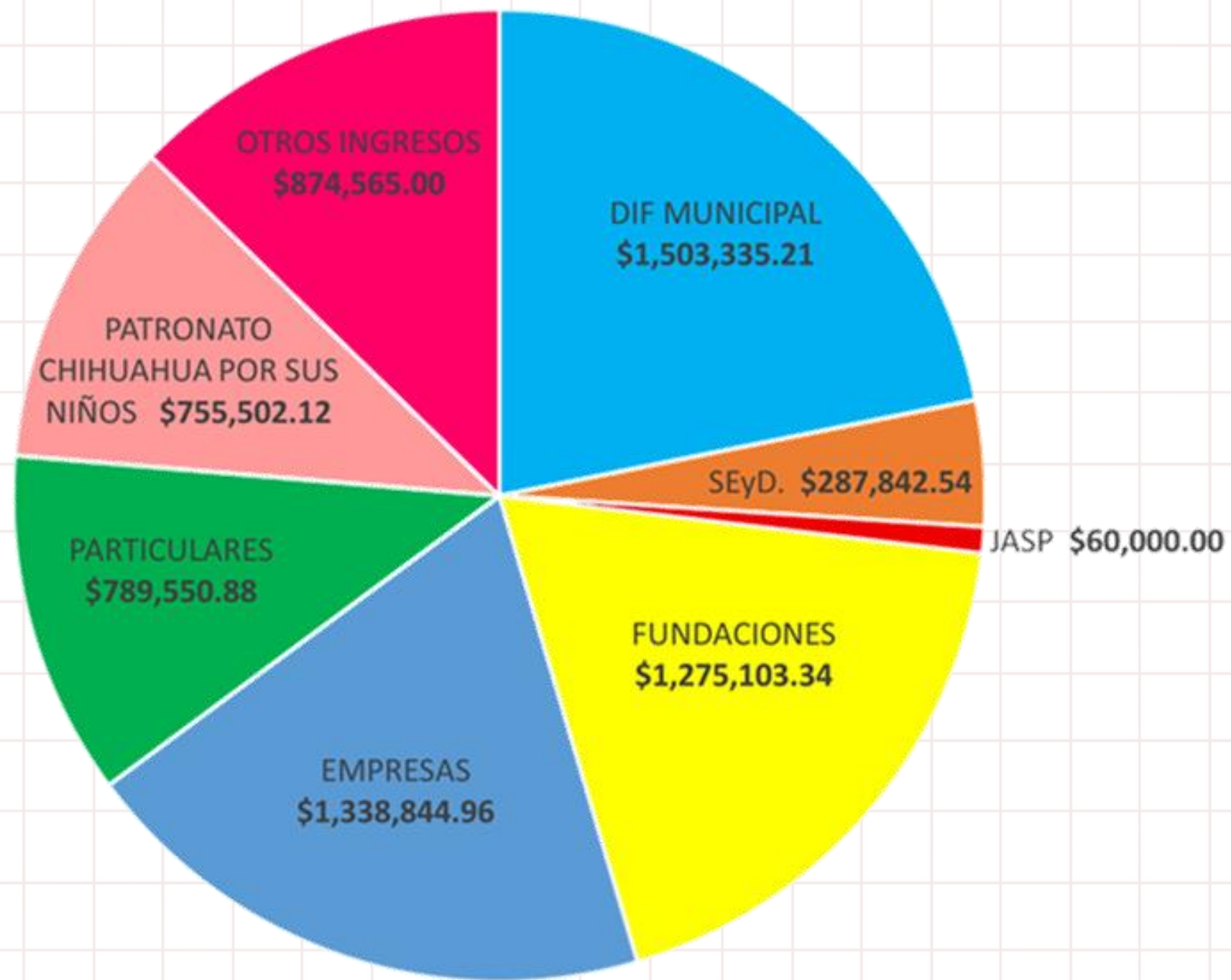
The most crucial stage in a person's development occurs during the first six years, which also coincides with their period of greatest vulnerability.

A child needs to experience a loving relationship: love humanizes them and acts as an antibody against life's difficulties, protecting and defending them from the dangers of the environment in which they are growing up.

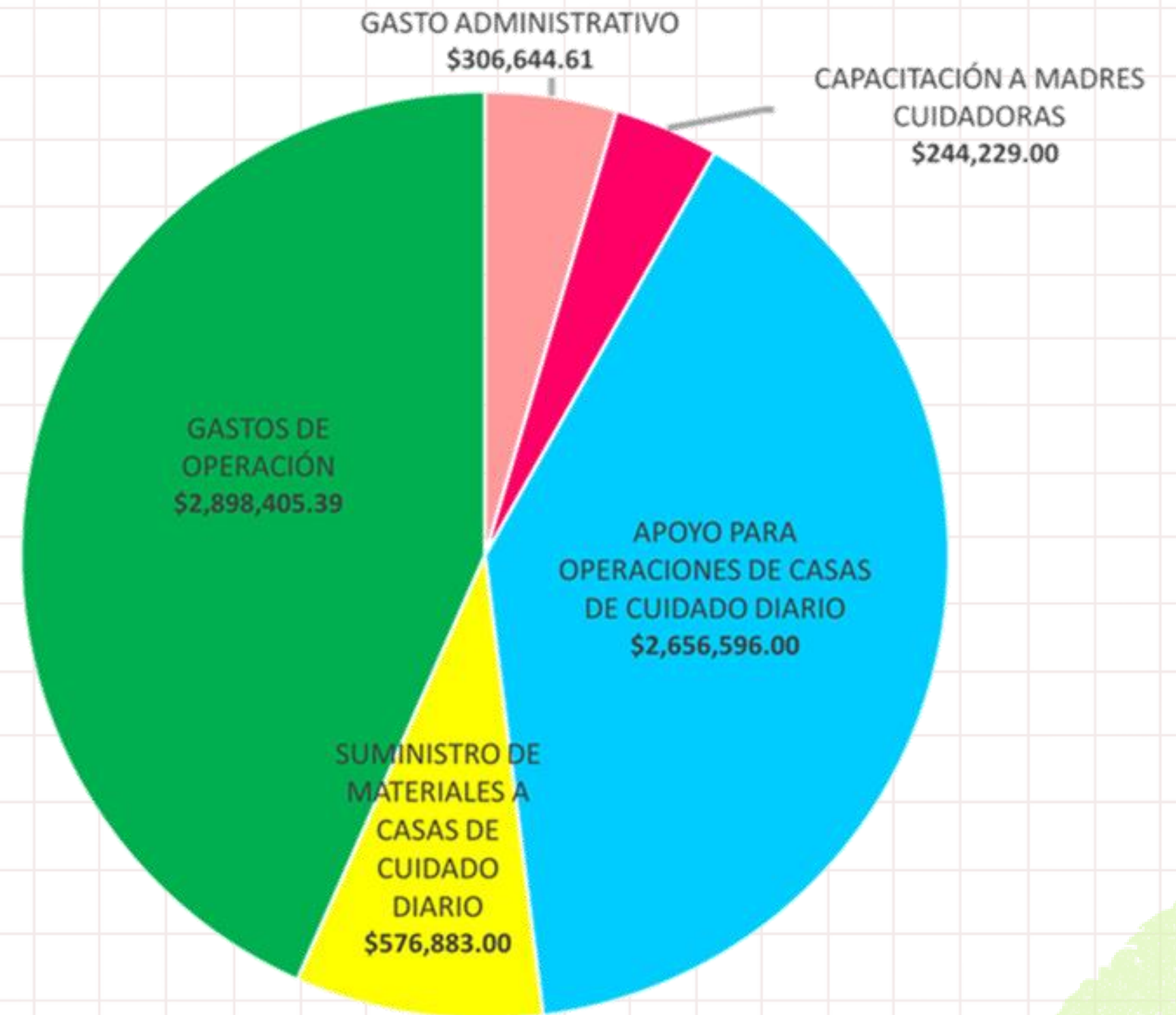

The experiences and shared life in the Day Care Centers will be decisive for their adult life, as the protection, security, and love they receive every day are the most important factors in shaping the individual they will become.

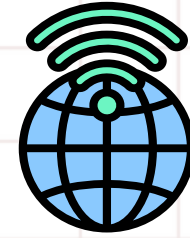
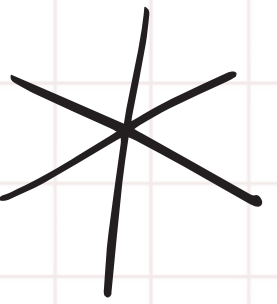

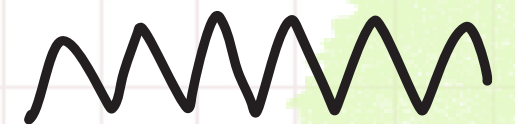
